TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF HUNT

1. There is no rain date. The hunt will be conducted as scheduled. Registrants only will be allowed in the hunt area.
2. Fees must accompany registration form and are non-refundable. Good check or money order is acceptable, no charge cards will be accepted, incomplete registration of those unaccompanied by the proper fees will not be honored, and will not be returned. A \$25.00 charge will be assessed for any returned checks, and only cash or money order will then be accepted as payment. Failure to meet this condition will result in legal action being taken.
3. At check in, registrants will be issued a name badge showing eligibility to participate. This badge must be clearly visible at all times during the hours of the hunt. Failure to observe this condition will result in being escorted from the hunt area. No hunting in the designated hunt area will be allowed before or after the posted hours of the hunt on either day.
4. All lodging, food, and other expenses are the responsibility of the registrant.
5. Genesee Valley Treasure Seekers or Beaver Meadows Campground assumes no liability for loss, damage, or injury to equipment, registrants or guests attending the hunt.
6. **It is the Hunters responsibility to set the channel on his detector so as not to interfere with other hunters**
7. The hunt is being conducted on the honor system. Registrants and guests will conduct themselves in an appropriate manner. Anyone observed engaging in any activity that may be construed as misconduct will be asked by security to leave the area immediately and will not be allowed to return. Misconduct will be reported to the Hunt Master. Anyone asked to leave the hunt will not be eligible to win prizes. Examples of misconduct, include, but are not limited to, any illegal activity, fighting, lewdness, use of alcohol while hunting, use of offensive language, failure to replace dirt after digging, etc. Determination will be made and appropriate action taken by the Hunt Master at the time of infraction or upon investigation of any complaints received.
8. Prizes will be awarded at the conclusion of each hunt
9. **NO PI (PULSE INDUCTION) DETECTORS ARE ALLOWED AND HEADSETS ARE REQUIRED FOR ALL HUNTS**
10. **Diggers may be no wider than 3", and NO Shovels allowed.**
